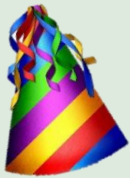
Meeting: 10 December

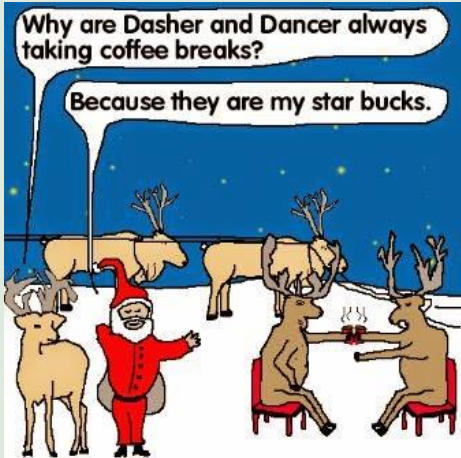
